WE AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS UPON ISSUANCE OF THE PERMIT:

1. To restore all disturbed surfaces to their original condition and adhere to specifications or restrictions as outlined below.
2. That disturbance to the road surface and shoulders will be kept at a minimum and that trenches under roadway, berms, and drives will be backfilled with gravel and tamped, so that settlement of materials will be minimized. If settlement does occur, additional suitable material will be put into place and compacted.
3. All crossings where said road is hard-surfaced (blacktop, concrete & chip & seal, etc.) will be made using boring method unless further permission is granted from the governing authority regarding cutting the pavement. If an open cut is permitted, the road surface at the trench will be replaced with material of type that was removed and the new surface will conform with the grade of the undisturbed surface.
4. Traffic will be maintained at all times, unless permission is granted by the governing authority to close the road. All necessary lights, signs, barricades, and/or flagmen and watchman will be placed on the job for protection of traffic at all times, day and night, during the time this work is being done and that instructions given by the governing authority as to handling of traffic will be fully complied with.
 - Further, all traffic control devices used shall conform to the current standards set forth in the Ohio Manual of Uniform Control Devices.
5. To assume the responsibility for and save the governing authority, as signed below, harmless from any and all claims arising from the work performed, for personal injuries and property damages due to the direct sole negligence of the applicant, and to defend any action arising therefrom.
6. To notify all property owners within the construction area at least two (2) working days prior to work beginning.
7. All mailboxes, signs, yards, driveways, drainage structures, fences, ditches, sidewalks, or other pertinent property damages or removal during initial construction or future maintenance will be replaced or repaired as good as or better than existing.
8. Any drainage tiles encountered will be repaired or replaced.
9. * With minor exceptions, the proposed cable will be placed as close as possible to the fence line at a depth of 30-36 inches.

10. Where possible, pedestals will be located in the existing fence line or apparent right-of-way with all loops to such equipment usually maintaining 36-inch depth under existing ditch lines. It is proposed to bury cable in a trench around the end of drainage structures at a depth of approximately 36 inches.
11. If, in the future, improvements or relocations are made to any of the above portions of roads, it will be the financial responsibility of the applicant or successors to move or relocate such installations at the request of the governing authority.
12. To notify all utilities in the right-of-way two (2) working days prior to construction by calling the Ohio Utilities Protection Service at 1-800-362-2764 for notification of member utilities.
13. * To notify the governing authority from which the permit was issued at least one (1) working day prior to the start of actual construction.
14. Underground electric and gas line installation shall adhere to the following:
 - a. Minimum depth for placement within the right-of-way is four (4) feet.
 - b. Twelve (12) inches of sand shall be placed on top of the electric line or gas line
 - c. Warning tape shall be placed six (6) to twelve (12) inches above the sand
 - d. Warning markers shall be placed above ground indicating buried electric or gas lines have been placed within the right-of-way
 - e. All road crossings must be done by boring under the roadway at a minimum depth of four (4) feet. All electric line must be encased in schedule 40 plastic pipe or SDR-35 plastic pipe. If the gas line is PPHP pipe it does not have to be encased. If it is not the PPHP pipe, then it must be encased in schedule 40 plastic pipe or SDR-35 plastic pipe.
 - f. Water lines must be encased in PVC plastic pipe.

15. Permission herewith granted is limited to the right vested in the Public or Preble County by the recorded dedication or by the occupation of this right-of-way.
